**On December 7, 1998 one of our employees was involved in an accidental (Electrical - Contact) with a high voltage power line while performing normal work duties. The work was being done on a 7200\ 12470 Wye system. The injury was to the right elbow, right forearm and right hand. The employee came in contact with an energized portion of a lightning arrester and a ground wire with right elbow and right hand. Our employee will recover 100% and be back to normal duties within thirty days.**

**However I wanted to write a letter to you, to let you know that the F R Clothing from Riverside Manufacturing Co. done it's job. I am completely satisfied on the performance of the garment. It is very apparent that our employee suffered a severe flash during the contact and limited damage was done to the shirt.**
