This test method does not apply to the electrical contact or electrical shock hazard.

Based on the data obtained and analysed in accordance with the latest version of the applicable standards, the following Arc Rating was calculated.

Arc Thermal Performance Value, ATPV = 39.2 Cal/cm² Heat Attenuation Factor, HAF = 89.6%




